On Friday 4/8/11 the Opelousas Police Department arrested Eddie Edmond of 925 Celeste St. Opelousas, La. on charges of 4cts. Of Attempted First Degree Murder following a shooting that occurred on 4/2/11 in the early morning hours. According to Chief Perry

Gallow on the morning of 4/2/11 Opelousas Police received a call of shots fired on Celeste St. in Opelousas Louisiana. Upon officers arrival on the scene it was found that the shooter had fled the area. The investigation revealed that Eddie Edmond fired four shots into a vehicle occupied by four females that had pulled up to a residence on Celeste St... Fortunately no one in the vehicle was hit. The females left the area once the shots began ringing out. Following that morning the Opelousas Police Department began a search for Edmonds but was unsuccessful in locating him. On Friday 4/8/11 the Opelousas Police Department received a tip from the public which led officers to Edmonds residence. Prior to officers arriving, Edmonds left the area. Officers then searched the area and were able to locate Edmonds on a nearby highway. Officers took Edmonds into custody without incident. Edmonds was then transported to the Opelousas city jail and booked in on charges of 4cts. Of Attempted First Degree Murder and Criminal Damage to Property. Edmonds currently remains in the Opelousas City Jail without bond. Chief Perry Gallow would like to thank the public for calling with information. All information is kept confidential.
