In the early morning hours of August 14, 2010 the Opelousas Police Department's Crime Suppression Team closed down another drug dealers business. Opelousas Police Chief Perry Gallow said the CST Team had been watching a residence in the 800 block of St.Cyr Street for a few weeks and gathered enough information to get a search warrant issued for the house. Officers waited to execute the warrant at around 3:00A.M. on Saturday morning because intelligence indicated that the suspects felt more comfortable conducting business during this late hour believing law enforcement presence was not as prominent as other hours of the day or night. Well they were wrong. The CST Team executed the search warrant and arrested two brothers, who were selling marijuana and crack cocaine from their residence at 809 St. Cyr St. Officers located approximately 2lbs of marijuana, and approximately a 1/2oz. of crack cocaine in the residence, as well as \$4100.00 in cash, two weapons and a stolen flat screen television.

Also during the investigation CST officers determined that Mr. Ledayrick Ferguson had a 16 year old female present in the home with him, and that he had engaged in inappropriate sexual intercourse with minor female. Mr. Ledayrick Ferguson was booked on a number of narcotics charges and carnal knowledge of a juvenile. Mr. Kellup Ferguson was booked on several narcotics charges. The Opelousas Police Dept and the Crime Suppression Team pledge to keep fighting illegal drug trafficking in the City of Opelousas, and this is an example of how our Department is working 24/7 to keep our city and its citizens safe.

I would like to express thanks to the citizens of Opelousas who provide valuable narcotics information, that make these arrest possible. I want the citizens to rest assured that the police department is constantly conducting and continuing its war on

illegal drug activity.
